


HEALING THE BROKEN

3 LEVELS

MILD. MODERATE. SEVERE

The soul is comprised of mind, will, and emotions. (Matthew 22:37) The soul may be wounded from mild to severe levels and can be:

Brused Fractured Broken Shattered

DISASSOCIATIVE IDENTITY DISORDER

Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), previously known as Multiple Personality Disorder, causes a person to experience two or more distinct identities or personality states, each with its own behaviors, memories, will, and thought patterns.

What does that mean for ministers? As ministers, it is important to distinguish between the demonic, the person, and presenting unprocessed trauma. Jesus heals mental, physical, and emotional issues. He also sets the captive free. How we work with Him will depend on the issue.

shâbar (h7665) shaw-bar' 1

Means: Break, Destroy, Break in pieces, break down. Hurt, torn, rend violently, crush, shatter quench

lēbāb (H3824) lay-bawb' 2

My heart: inner man, mind, will, heart, understanding

hābāš (H2280) khaw-bash' 3

a primitive root; to wrap firmly (especially a turban, compress, or saddle); figuratively, to stop, to rule:—bind (up), gird about, govern, healer, put, saddle, wrap about.

aphesis (G859) af'-es-is 4

Deliverance in the Greek: freedom; (figuratively) pardon:—deliverance, forgiveness, liberty, remission.

aichmālōtos (G164) aheekh-mal-o-tos 5

Captives in the Greek: properly, a prisoner of war, i.e. (genitive case) a captive:—captive.

iaomai (G2390) ee-ah'-om-ahee 6

Heal in the Greek: heal, make whole.

syntribō (G4937) soon-tree'-bo 7

Brokenhearted in the Greek: to crush completely, i.e. to shatter (literally or figuratively):—break (in pieces), broken to shivers (+ -hearted), bruise.

THE TRUTH.

- Jesus has a special place for those who have been mistreated and broken. Psalm 34:18
- Throughout the Bible, we see measures taken to help the weak and not harm them. Pro. 19:17, 14:31

Signs of BROKENNESS

- The person suddenly feels like a child or like they are in the middle of the trauma.
- Vivid memory of a traumatic incident
- Difficulty concentrating or focusing
- Sudden shift in mood
- Blinking with change in mood or facial expression
- Surprise in surroundings
- The person feels like they're in a dream or watching their life from outside
- Confusion or memory gaps
- Feeling disconnected from the body
- Suddenly confused or not sure where they are
- Panic and crying
- Body Memories
- Hearing voices or chatter like lots of ages talking at one time
- Dual emotions. E.g.: Very interested but then also repulsed.
- Depression
- Anxiety
- Suicidal Thoughts

What demons do not do:

- Demons cannot express emotions that reflect a conscience. Demons show rage, frustration, and hatred, but are incapable of showing true grief, sorrow, or remorse.
- Demons do not “connect” relationally—alters do. Demons will give information and make threats and accusations, but they have no desire or ability to connect with you as a person. They maintain their focus wholly on their agenda of preserving their connection to the person through whom they are speaking.
- Demons do not change their perspective or agenda, no matter how strongly you argue or rationalize with them.
- Demons do not relate to the concept of being a specific age.
- Demons respond to spiritual warfare—trauma does not. Demons can be resistant, but once the free will bonds binding them to an individual or an alter identity are renounced, they have to respond to commands issued in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ.
