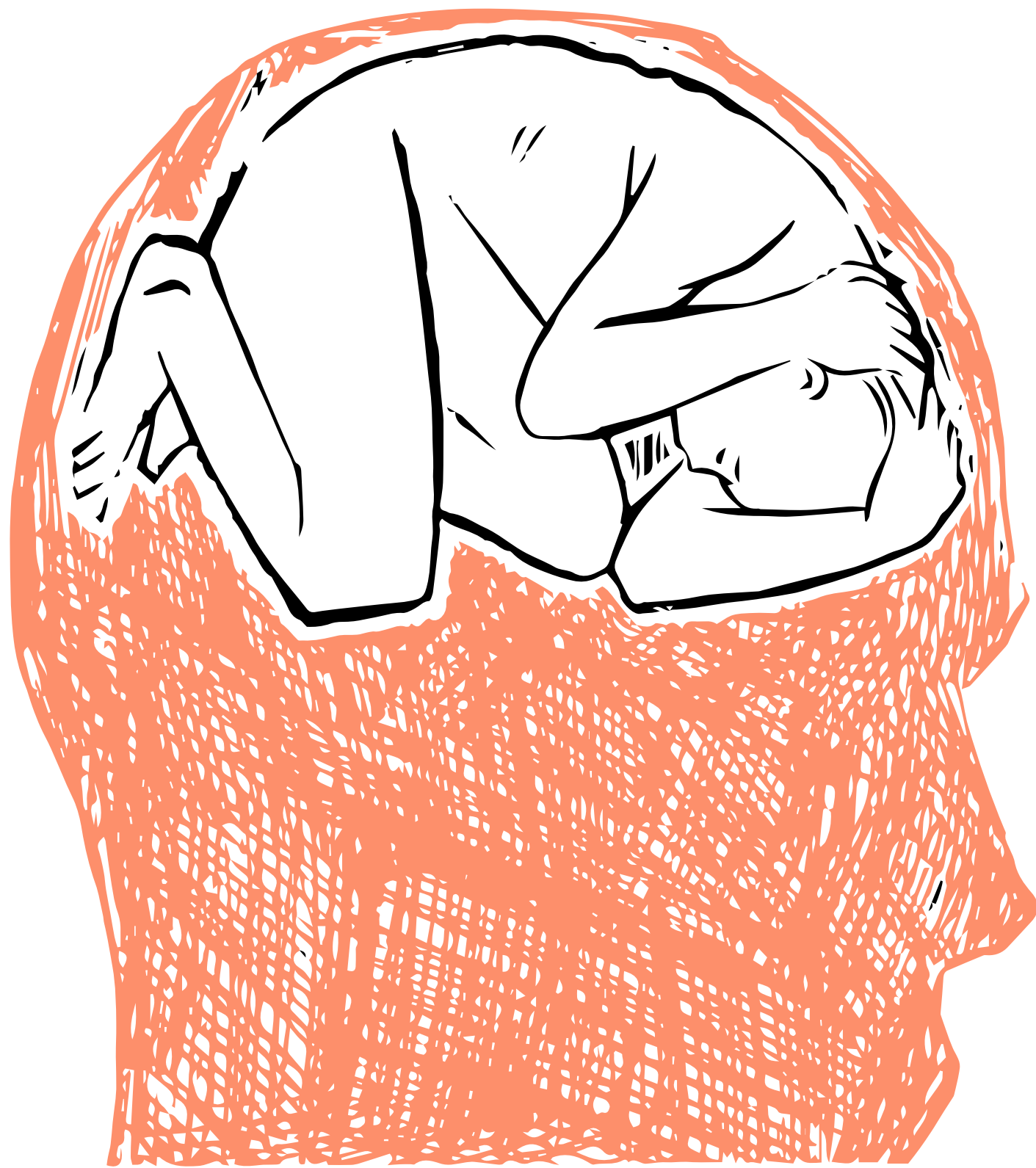

5 compounding Issues



- Physical Illness Ex: Flu
- Mental Illness Bipolar
- Demonic Oppression Tormening Fear
- Complex Trauma Phobias
- Environmental & Choices Bad diet

Don't assume it is or isn't a demon. Sometimes it's a combination!
Some people will come saying they want the devil cast out, don't
assume that's the issue!

Mental Illness Vs Demonic Issues

- You can't cast out mental illness or physical sickness.
- Demons can't be medicated, but the body subdued..
- Communication from mental illness is often illogical.
- Communication from demons is prideful, mocking, typically coherent, accusatory, and can be rational.

Mental Illness Vs Demonic Issues

- Demons can know things a person would not know. They communicate to one another and are old creatures.
- Demons have the ability to produce supernatural strength and can perform smokescreen illusions.

Mental Illness Vs Demonic Issues

- Those with mental illness may think they have supernatural knowledge, but it doesn't make sense typically. Hallucinations may be a factor of thinking that things are supernatural.

How to tell the Difference?



- Gift of Discernment
- Word of Knowledge
- Open doors: Involvement in occult, drug use, etc.
- Observation: If ministry isn't working and symptoms indicate the issue.
- The person may be able to tell you.

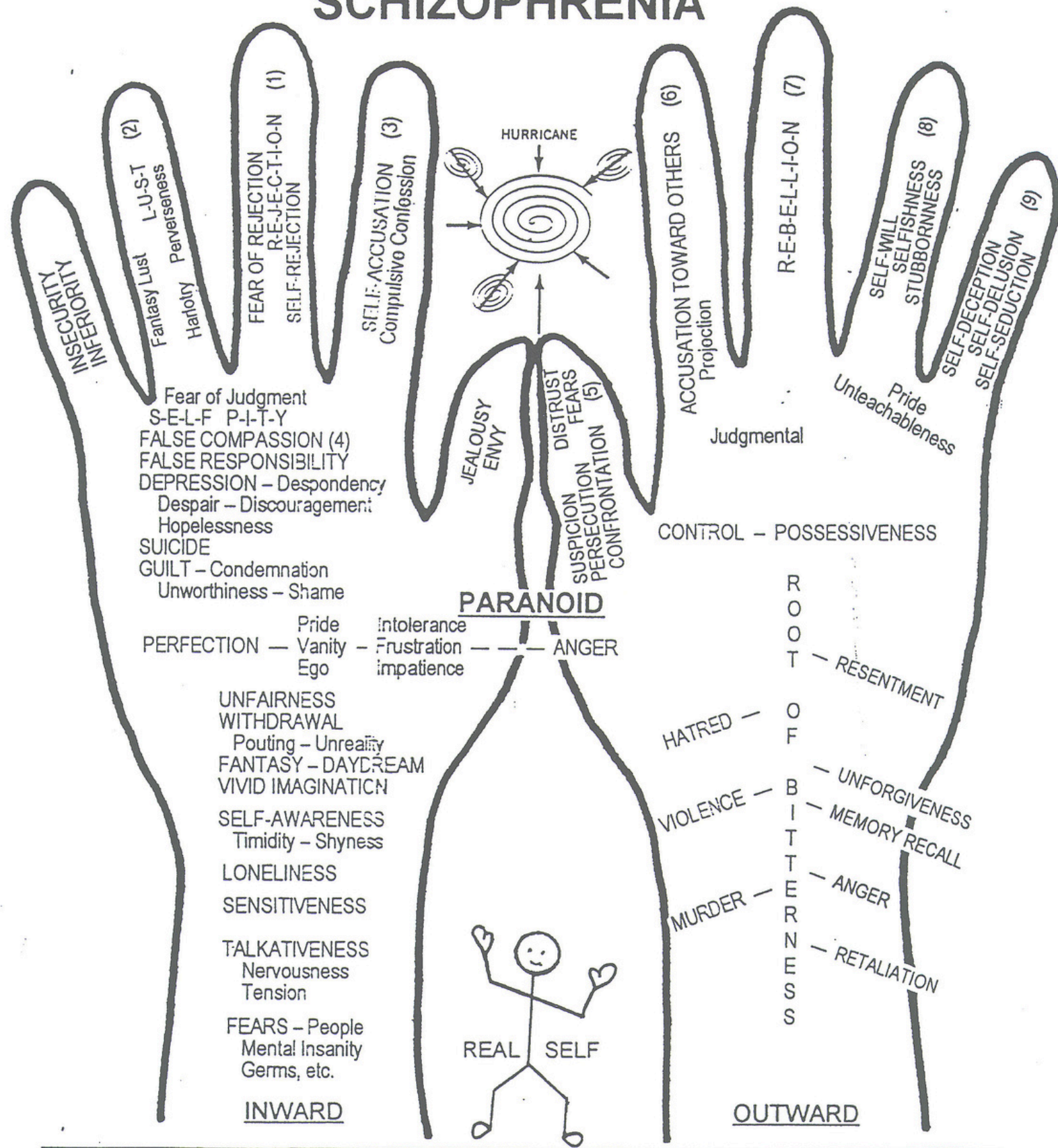


Schizophrenia Revelation

Schizophrenia revelation by Ida Mae Hammond

1. Keeps one from giving and receiving love — both GOD'S & MAN'S.
2. Weds one to the world for love.
3. Makes one tell all seeking attention, punishment and correction.
4. Includes inordinate affection for animals.
5. With honesty at all costs — seeking evidence for suspicions.

6. Keeps one from looking at self. Projects one's own faults into others.
7. Disobedience and anti-submissiveness.
8. Weds one to selfish desires.
9. Both mental & spiritual. Seductive: to tempt, mislead, decoy. Delusion: a misleading of the mind, false belief, fixed misconception. In psychiatry: a false belief regarding self — common in paranoia.

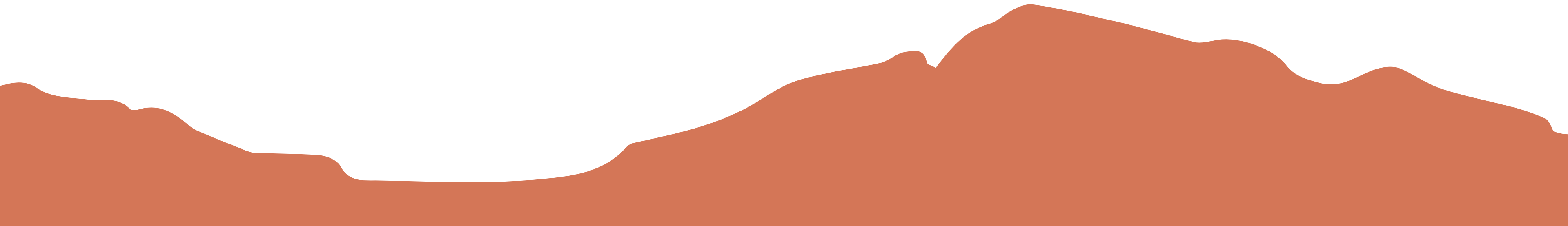

Everything on the rebellion side of the personality is a direct compensation or complement to everything on the rejection side. The swings in the personality to each side causes double-mindedness.


- David wrote about depression, anxiety, and feelings of abandonment. (Psalms)
 - Elijah wanted to die after a great spiritual victory (1 Kings 19)
 - Job felt grief, despair and effects of trauma (Job 3)
 - Jeremiah experienced isolation, despair, and was known as the weeping prophet. (Lamentations)
 - Hannah wept bitterly (1 Samuel 1)

- King Saul exhibited fits of rage, paranoia, and deep melancholy, often described as being tormented by a "harmful spirit" (1 Samuel)
- Nebuchadnezzar went mad. His behavior was iradite and wild. (Daniel 4)



Mark 5:2-4

² And when He had come out of the boat, immediately there met Him out of the tombs a man with an **unclean spirit**, ³ who had his **dwelling among the tombs**; and **no one could bind him**, not even with chains, ⁴ because he had often been bound with shackles and chains. And the **chains had been pulled apart by him**, and the shackles broken in pieces; neither could anyone **tame him**. NKJV

⁵ And always, night and day, he was **in the mountains and in the tombs, crying out and cutting himself** with stones.
